Updated damage and recovery reports for facilities operated by Shindengen Group companies are as

complete, and despite continued restrictions to the electrical power supply, almost all

products are once again under production.

scheduled to begin this week on a sequential basis.

A) Inspection of production equipment is largely complete, and despite continued restrictions

to the electrical power supply, production is scheduled to begin this week on a sequential

basis.

We anticipate that, because of rolling blackouts implemented by Tohoku Electric Power Company

and difficulties in obtaining gas and other fuels due to the breakdown of distribution networks, a

significant period of time will be required to return to normal production levels.

levels despite being affected by rolling blackouts implemented by Tokyo Electric Power Company

and difficulties in obtaining materials.
